The EAEEIE Annual Conference is held every year by the European Association for Education in Electrical and Information Engineering (EAEEIE). The 35th Annual Conference of EAEEIE is jointly organized by the **EAEEIE, the University of Ruse “Angel Kanchev” and the Scientific University of Ruse**. The conference is technically co-sponsored by the **IEEE** through the **IEEE Bulgarian Section - IEEE Conference #70372**.
